


WHAT SHOULD A **RESIDENT EXPERT** DO TO PREPARE

STEP 1- KNOW THE SCENE AND ACT YOU ARE AN EXPERT OF BY:

- ✓ READING ALL THE CHARACTER'S LINES
- ✓ UNDERSTANDING ALL THE MAJOR EVENTS OF THE ACT/ SCENE
- ✓ KNOW WHAT DAY YOU ARE AN EXPERT, AND COME PREPARED

STEP 2 - PREPARE BY:



- ✓ READ THE LINES OF ALL CHARACTERS IN YOUR SCENE. ADDITIONALLY, LISTEN TO THE MP3 SO YOU CAN JUDGE THE ACTING OF THE ACTORS.
- ✓ UNDERSTAND THE ENTIRE SCENE BY READING THE LINES (as above) AND READING THE SUMMARIES FROM  GradeSaver
Getting you the grade since 1999.
- ✓ TAKE DETAILED NOTES IN THE ORDER IN WHICH THE PLAY OCCURRED SO YOU CAN CRITIQUE OR ENDORSE THE ACTORS

STEP 3 - ON THE DAY OF THE CHALLENGE:

- ✓ COME WITH NOTES. YOU SHOULD KNOW THE EVENTS WELL, AND EVEN HAVE A

CLUE AS TO WHEN AN ACTOR USES A LINE FROM THE PLAY. PERHAPS HAVE THE PLAY AND FLIP THROUGH IT AS THE ACTORS PERFORM. BELOW IS A CHART OF HOW YOU SHOULD BE THINKING ON THE DAY AS A RESIDENT EXPERT.
